ENGAGEMENT TIERS

Project

A defined piece of work with a clear end: a documentation set, a migration, a style guide.

€85 / hour

Usually quoted as a fixed price once scope is agreed

- ✓ Scoping call and written brief
- ✓ Fixed price after the brief is signed off
- ✓ Two rounds of revisions included
- ✓ Source files and templates handed over
- ✓ 30 days of follow-up questions at no charge

Starts within 2–3 weeks

Typically 2 project slots per month

MOST CLIENTS

Retainer

Ongoing documentation work alongside a product team, with a predictable monthly commitment.

€76 / hour

Billed monthly in advance; see the retainer table below

- ✓ Reserved capacity each month
- ✓ Priority over project and ad-hoc work
- ✓ Attendance at your sprint rituals
- ✓ Rolling backlog rather than fixed scope
- ✓ Up to 20% of unused hours roll forward one month

Same or next working day

Three retainer slots, one currently open

Ad hoc

Short tasks, reviews and rescue jobs where you need someone this week.

Billed in 30-minute increments, minimum 2 hours

- ✓ No scoping process — start immediately
- ✓ Reviews, audits and second opinions
- ✓ Emergency release documentation
- ✓ Written summary of what I did and why
- ✓ Convertible to a project or retainer at any time

WHAT IS ALWAYS INCLUDED

- A written brief before work starts, so we both know what "done" means
- Weekly progress notes for anything running longer than two weeks
- Plain-language explanations of anything technical I change in your setup
- Source files, in an editable format, handed over at the end
- Accessibility review of anything I publish, to WCAG 2.2 AA
- Confidentiality by default — no client work appears in my portfolio without written permission

WHAT IS NOT INCLUDED

- Translation and localisation (I can recommend two people)
- Illustration, video production and screencast recording
- Hosting, domains and third-party tool subscriptions
- Ongoing maintenance after a project closes, unless retained
- Legal, medical or regulatory sign-off of any content
- Ghost-writing for publication under someone else's byline

TERMS OF BUSINESS

1. Rates are held until 31 January 2027 and are exclusive of VAT, charged where applicable.
2. Projects require a 30% deposit before work begins; the balance is invoiced on delivery and due within 14 days.

3. Retainers are invoiced monthly in advance, and either side may end them with 30 days' notice.
4. Unused retainer hours roll forward one month up to 20% of the monthly allocation, and are not refundable.
5. Time is tracked in 30-minute increments and a breakdown accompanies every invoice.
6. Copyright in delivered work transfers to you on final payment. Until then I retain it.
7. Reusable assets I bring with me — templates, tooling, checklists — remain mine, and you get a perpetual licence to use them.
8. Interest on overdue invoices accrues at the statutory rate; work pauses on any invoice more than 21 days overdue.
9. I do not sign non-competes, and I work with more than one client in a sector at a time.
